### 1. Tuition Fees

The total tuition fees payable for your Jeonju University program can be found on our website. If your application to study is successful, you will need to pay the first semester tuition fees plus the total cost of your student health insurance prior to applying for your student visa. These fees and methods for payment will be detailed in your Letter of Offer.

### 2. Cost of Living

An estimate of average annual cost of living for international students is approximately USD \$10,000 which would include accommodation, food, transport, phone and internet. However, depending on your preferences this amount could be lower or higher.

### 3. Study Concessions and Discounts

International students are entitled to discounts on their tuition fees and will be offered a variety of scholarships when they study at our campus. In addition to this, you will be offered concession prices for many services such as entry to cinemas, museums, foods and more.

## 1. Korean Language and Academic Entry Requirements

For all Jeonju University programs, you need to meet the Korean language proficiency requirement, even though you do not, we will let you in our undergraduate program through “Pathway”, and help you organize a Korean language program at your Korean language institution.

For all Jeonju University programs, you also need to meet the overall academic entry requirement; a list of international qualifications equivalent to Korean high school is provided in the academic entry requirement.

## 2. Conditions for Progressing to your Jeonju University Transfer

If you wish to transfer, you will need to complete at least 2 years or acquire 65 credits in your university or graduate from 3 years colleges to be eligible to progress.

## 3. Application Schedule

#### b) Requirement

##### 1) Nationality

Both the applicant and his/her parents are not citizens of Korea and the applicant is a high school graduate or has attained an equivalent level of education.

Both the applicant and his/her parents are required to acquire foreign citizenship before commencing their education course corresponding to that of high school in Korea.

An applicant who has renounced his/her Korean citizenship from dual citizenships cannot apply as an international student.

##### 2) Education

The applicant who undertook entire educations(both primary and secondary from the first year of elementary school to high school graduation) outside of Korea.

Jeonju University does not acknowledge international schools located in Korea as "Foreign schools."

Applicants who completed school curriculum through language school, foundation course, continuing education, correspondence education and cyber learning are not eligible to apply.

### a) Financial Certification

- 1) Resident Outside of Korea : Bank balance more than USD \$18,000.
- 2) Resident Inside of Korea : Bank balance more than KRW 22,000,000.
- 3) Important Note for the Submission of Bank Certificate of Balance.
  - Submit a bank statement showing a minimum balance of USD \$18,000 along with account holder.
  - Submit a bank statement issued by the bank format along with the contact details.
  - The account holder can be either applicant or applicant's parents.
  - If an applicant would be hard to approve a minimum balance due to any reasons, he/she can remit USD \$18,000 to Jeonju University bank account.

**b) Applicants Residing in China : Additional Documents to Submit**

- 1) A Copy of Family Relations
  - A certificate of family relation shall include all identifying details about the family.
  - If one of applicant's family is not included in the certificate of family relations, the applicant shall issue additional documents through the police station.
  - If applicant's parents divorced, the relevant certificate needs to be submitted.
  - If applicant's parents passed away, the relevant certificate needs to be submitted.
  - The workplace between a certificate of family relations and a proof of employment shall be the same.
- 2) Proof of Employment for Applicant's Parents(Original and Copy)
  - Workplace, duration, position, issued department shall be specified in the proof of employment.
  - Parents' identification number shall be specified in the proof of employment correctly.
  - Jeonju University will contact the workplace so the correct contact needs to be specified in the proof of employment.

## 5. How to Apply

- a) All documents related to this admission shall be recorded in Korean language.
- b) All documents related to this admission shall be submitted on or before the application deadline.
- c) All relevant documents need to be submitted on time.

- d) Applicants who wish to transfer Jeonju University can apply for any majors.(However, applicants who wish to transfer as 4<sup>th</sup> grade need to be matched with the major)
- e) Applicants cannot cancel or modify documents once they are applied and all submitted documents will not be returned.
